Policy/Directive for promoting non GTVCCA activities on the website.

GTVCCA Website Posting Policy

This policy applies to activities which are not organized by GTVCCA and which are to be promoted anywhere on the website (<u>https://greentreecommunitycenter.com/</u>). The policy facilitates the approval of activities by the website administrator(s) so that they do not have to be individually approved by the board. Activities which are not in compliance with this policy can and must be approved on an individual basis by the board for promotion on the website.

The activity promoted must

- be targeted at the members of GTV.
- must be open to all members of GTV.
- cannot be in violation of BC law, constitution and bylaws of the GTVCCA or this policy.
- not be political, religious, discriminatory or promoting violence.
- be clearly described as not being organised by the GTVCCA.
- be happening at the facilities at the Rec. Centre as well as the park area south of the Rec. Centre.
- not place the center in a liability situation.
- promote or sell any goods or services other than what is directly related to the activity.

While a charity can be provided for payment, it can not be the main purpose of the event to support charities.

The GTVCCA constitution outlines the following in regards to promoting activities:

2. (c) to provide recreational benefits and facilities for the enjoyment and use of all the above residents, and in particular to operate and maintain a community centre on the lands and premises adjacent to Green Tree Village known and described as:

Lot 126 - District Lot 81 - Group 1 - Plan48323 - New Westminster District;

2. (d) to promote and develop recreational activities for the common good and social welfare of the above residents;

3. (e) to assist, encourage, cooperate and participate with others engaged in undertakings consistent with the objects of the Society;
